

Senior Community Organizer

St. Nicks Alliance is seeking a **Senior Community Organizer** to provide leadership to community organizers, community leaders and volunteers responsible for environmental justice, anti-displacement, affordable housing and community planning campaigns. The position is supervised by the **Deputy Director for Community Preservation.**

Responsibilities

- Lead and supervise a team of community organizers, interns and volunteers working on housing and environmental justice issues in North Brooklyn.
- Provide leadership in the development of St Nicks Alliance's community organizing capacity.
- Provide leadership developing and implementing a plan to outreach, train and engage North Brooklyn residents into affordable housing and anti-displacement and environmental justice issues campaigns.
- Provide leadership strengthening our grassroots community organizing efforts around affordable housing and anti-displacement.
- Assist with the design, outreach and implementation of a leadership development process to build the capacity of community leaders and members.
- Provide leadership facilitating the development and implementation of local and citywide community organizing campaigns, especially those targeting problem landlords, lenders and policies that contribute to deteriorating housing conditions.
- Assist in writing reports to current funders and assist with grant development

Qualifications/Requirements

- Candidate must be fluently bilingual (English-Spanish).
- Minimum of one year of supervising experience
- Minimum of two years of demonstrated experience with community organizing, mobilizing and campaign development.
- Demonstrated experience with leadership development.
- Ability to work evenings and weekends (as necessary).
- Ability to meet deadlines and manage multiple projects at the same time.
- Excellent interpersonal, written, and communication ability and strong public speaking skills.
