*Renews \$75K grant for St. Nicks Alliance's
mobile library and literacy motivation: the BK Story Voyager*

WILLIAMSBURG, BK, New York (June 2, 2026) – Guru Krupa Foundation, Inc. (GKF) renewed their support to St. Nicks Alliance's literacy initiative: the BK Story Voyager in October 2025. GKF presented St. Nicks Alliance a grant in the amount of \$75,000 for one year toward the support of the BK Story Voyager, which will travel to 18 elementary after-school centers and summer camps to bring consistent, in-person learning with literacy instruction, book borrowing, and book giveaways. The funds will help improve literacy and address the learning loss of 2,000+ K–5 students.
